

Board of Police Commissioners

June 29, 2017

The Board of Police Commissioners met on June 29, 2017 in the Police Department Conference room. Chairman Marvin Garlick called the meeting to order at 07:32 a.m.

New Business:

- a) **Promotion-** There will not be a retest due to the list still being valid. Wisdom stated that it is Chief Piotrowski's choice out of the top three Sergeant's candidates.

- b) **Possible list merge/testing for new hires-** Chief Piotrowski stated that we have merged lists in the past. The candidates on the list would be given the option to retest. Wisdom asked if the candidates on the list expire, Chief Piotrowski stated that if they don't retest then they expire in November. Garlick asked if there was time to do a test before we would need to hire. Chief Piotrowski stated that there would be time but, maybe we should extend the application dates and that we are on the waitlist for Suburban Law Enforcement in DuPage for an academy date. WE currently have a spot on the Cook County Academy in Bellville, but could get bumped for agencies that already have a new officer hired. Wisdom asked if we would be considering lateral entries, but there was not a conclusive decision made on the idea.

Emerick made a motion to direct Jessica Damewood to do all of the advertising and communications for the new hire process. Wisdom seconded the motion. 3-ayes.

- c) **Retirement-** There is a possibility of an officer retiring in August 2018. There has not been anything put into writing.
