Whenever work described in the building permit application is altered to cause additional valuation, the additional fee shall be the difference between the original valuation and the valuation had the work been included in the original application valuation.

Fees for permits issued to the city are hereby waived.

Fee's for permits issued to schools, churches, or other governmental entities will be reduced by 20 percent. No fees shall be charged for permits issued to non-for-profit organizations primarily engaged in providing home repairs for free of charge to low-income homeowners.

The payment of the permit fee established by the building inspector shall be submitted along with the copy of the permit to the city clerk. Whenever the fee does not accompany the copy of the permit, the city clerk shall render a bill for fee.

POWER COST ADJUSTMENT

Power Cost Adjustment: In addition to the energy charges and sale tax as defined in the Rate Schedule, all electrical customers shall be charged each month a Power Cost Adjustment (PCA) per kilowatt hour billed. The Adjustment shall be computed and added to all energy billed, and is equal to the difference between \$0.05047 and the average per-kilowatt-hour cost of purchase power in the preceding Six Months

The Calculation of the PPA is as follows: (1) Total cost of purchased power in the proceeding six months (total cost) divided by total kwhs sold in the proceeding six months (total sold) minus \$0.05047 equals power cost adjustment per kilowatt hour (PCS) sold, state as follows: $TOTAL\ COST / TOTAL\ SOLD - \$0.05047 = PCA$. (2) Each customer's bill shall be increased or decreased, as the case may be, by the PCA times the kilowatt hours used. All bills to electric energy customers shall be adjusted monthly to reflect changes in the power cost adjustment.

AVOIDED COST CREDIT - SOLAR

Avoided cost credit of \$0.0907 per kWh will be applied to self-generation net metering customers excess energy as referenced in section 12 of the Geneseo Municipal Utilities Customer Self-Generation Net Metering Policy..

Avoided costs is calculated according to the following formula:
(Solar Weighted LMP + Value of Capacity Savings + Value of Transmission Savings) times Value of Distribution Loss Savings.
For the current year 2023 the avoided cost credit is calculated as follows:

$$\text{\$0.0907 per kWh} = (\text{\$0.0489} + \text{\$0.0251} + \text{\$.0116}) \times 106\%$$

Hotel Tax:

There is hereby levied and imposed upon all persons, firms or corporations engaged in the business of renting, leasing, or letting rooms in a Hotel which is located within the corporate limited of Geneseo, Illinois, a tax at a rate of five percent (5%) of the gross rental receipts from such renting, leasing or letting for any purpose for each twenty - four (24) hour period or portion thereof. Excluded from the gross rental receipts will be the proceeds of such rents, leasing or letting to permanent residents or displaced persons. The tax imposed herein shall be in addition to any and all other taxes and charges applicable to such Hotels, but such other taxes and charges shall not be construed to be a part of the gross rental receipts upon which this tax is levied.
