All bills to electric energy customers shall be adjusted monthly to reflect changes in the power cost adjustment.

Avoided cost credit of \$0.0379 per kWh will be applied to selfgeneration net metering customers excess energy as referenced in section 12 of the Geneseo Municipal Utilities Customer Self-Generation Net Metering Policy.

Avoided cost is calculated according to the following formula:

(Solar Weighted LMP + Value of Capacity Savings + Value of Transmission Savings) times Value of Distribution Loss Savings.

For the current year 2025 the avoided cost credit is calculated as follows:

\$0.0379 per kWh = (\$0.0235 + \$0.0021 + \$.0102) X 106%

There is hereby levied and imposed upon all persons, firms or corporations engaged in the business of renting, leasing, or letting rooms in a Hotel which is located within the corporate limited of Geneseo, Illinois, a tax at a rate of five percent (5%) of the gross rental receipts from such renting, leasing or letting for any purpose for each twenty - four (24) hour period or portion thereof.
