

Hydrant flushing will be September 28th - October 2nd from 4 a.m. - 4 p.m. The Water Department will be starting on the north side of town and working their way from east and west as they move in a southward direction street by street. Please note that the schedule is subject to change. Depending on how work progresses, crews may move ahead of the areas shown on the map or may not complete a specific as scheduled.

Hydrant Flushing:

Hydrant flushing is performed to remove any sediment that naturally accumulates in water pipes. These steps are taken to improve the overall water quality within the distribution system and to ensure the delivery of the highest quality of water possible. You may experience reduced water pressure or discoloration during flushing.

Is my water safe to drink after flushing?

Your water is safe to drink. Occasionally, water becomes discolored after hydrant flushing. **Please note that discoloration may be seen throughout town and may not only affect the immediate area where flushing is taking place.** This discoloration only affects the appearance of the water; it does not affect the taste or water quality. If this happens, run your cold water tap for a few minutes until the water clears. **You should avoid washing white and light colored clothing until the water clears.**
